AMENDED Administrative Order DD-124(NSBHL)

Dear Mr. Hawkins:

By Division Administrative Order DD-124, dated November 13, 1995, authorization was given Amoco Production Company ("Amoco") to directionally drill its Ealum Gas Com Well No. 1-R from a standard surface gas well location, being 1630 feet from the North line and 1130 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 33, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, to a **standard** bottom-hole gas well location in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool within a drilling window or "producing area" in the NE/4 of said Section 33 that is no closer than 790 feet to the quarter section lines.

Reference is now made to your letter with attachments dated December 6, 1995, whereby an amendment should be issued in this order to accurately reflect the actual bottom-hole location of this wellbore as being unorthodox.

The Division Director Finds That:

- This application was originally approved under the provisions of General Rule 111.D and Rule 2(b) of the "General Rules For The Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations For The Blanco-Mesaverde Pool",;
- (2) This amendment has been duly filed under the provisions of Division General Rules 111.D and 111.E and said Special Rule 2(d); and,
- (3) Amoco owns and operates wells in all affected offsetting 320-acre tracts to the captioned well, no notification was therefore required.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- (1) Division Administrative Order DD-124 is hereby amended to properly reflect the actual **unorthodox** bottomhole location for said Ealum Gas Com Well No. 1-R within the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool to be, more or less, 1890 feet from the North line and 594 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 33, Township 32 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (2) All other provisions of said Order DD-124, dated November 13, 1995, not in conflict with this change shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.
- (3) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
