Refer to the location diagram and to the wellsite cut and fill diagram (Figure No. 4). The blow pit will be constructed with a 2"/160' grade to allow positive drainage to the reserve pit and prevent liquids in the blow pit.

10. Plans for Restoration of the Surface

After completion of the proposed project, the location will be cleaned and leveled. The location will be left in such a condition that will enable reseeding operations to be carried out. Seed mixture as designated by the responsible government agency will be used. The reseeding operations will be performed during the time period set forth by the responsible governmental agency. The permanent location, facilities will be painted as designated by the responsible governmental agency.


