CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

1. Within 30 days after operations have been completed, please send a subsequent report of operations via Sundry Notice.
2. All new pit construction will be contained on the existing well pad. No off-location surface disturbance is approved. Pits to be reclaimed within 15 months of completion date.
3. Burn dike, if used, will be large enough to prevent damage to surrounding vegetation from flaring operations.
4. Pursuant to NTL 4A, part III.c, venting will not exceed a period of 30 days, or the production of 50 MMcf of gas, whichever occurs first.
