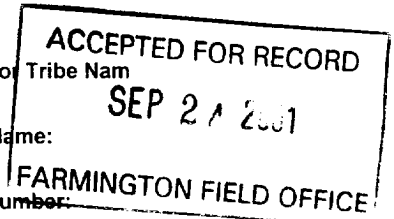

DRILL A 8" X 300' DEEP WELL GROUNDBED AND LOAD WITH 10-15, 2" X 60" ANODES BACKFILLED WITH 2500 LBS. OF LORESCO COKE BREEZE. TRENCH TO A DEPTH OF 18" TO 24" WITHIN THE EXISTING LEASE ROAD, TWO (2) #6 AC POWER CABLES APP. 1600' TO THE ALLISON UNIT 123. INSTALL STUB POLE, RECTIFIER, AND TRENCH A #8 DC NEGATIVE CABLE ON LOCATION TO PROTECT THE WELL CASING. ALL WORK TO BE PERFORMED ON LOCATION AND WITHIN PREVIOUSLY DISTURBED GROUNDS WITHIN THE LEASE.
