It is intended to alter the approved casing in the subject well as follows:
Intermediate depth changed to +/- 4373'. From surface to 4000' casing will be 7", 20.0#, J-55, ST&C and from 4000' to 4373' casing will be 7", 23.0#, J-55, LT&C. The intermediate casing will be cemented in two stages with the first stage consisting of 671 cuft of Premium Lite lead slurry and 124 cuft of Type III tail slurry (100% excess). The second stage will consist of 510 cuft of Premium Lite lead slurry (100% excess). Bowspring centralizers will be spaced every third joint off bottom to the base of the Ojo Alamo at 888'. Remainder of turbolizers and centralizers will be spaced as per original APD. The production liner will be a 4-1/2", 10.5#, J-55, ST&C. Production cement volumes will be 404 cuft of 65/35 Poz L (40% excess).
