

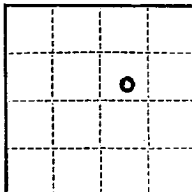

**Propose to:** Set 8 5/8" casing at 100' with 100 sacks cement. Drill through **Tocito** formation to approximately 2000'. Set 5 1/2" casing with 50 sacks cement to total depth. Perforate Tocito formation. Sand-oil frac with 20,000 lbs. sand and 20,000 gallons oil. Run 2 3/8" tubing to approximately 1950'. Install pump.

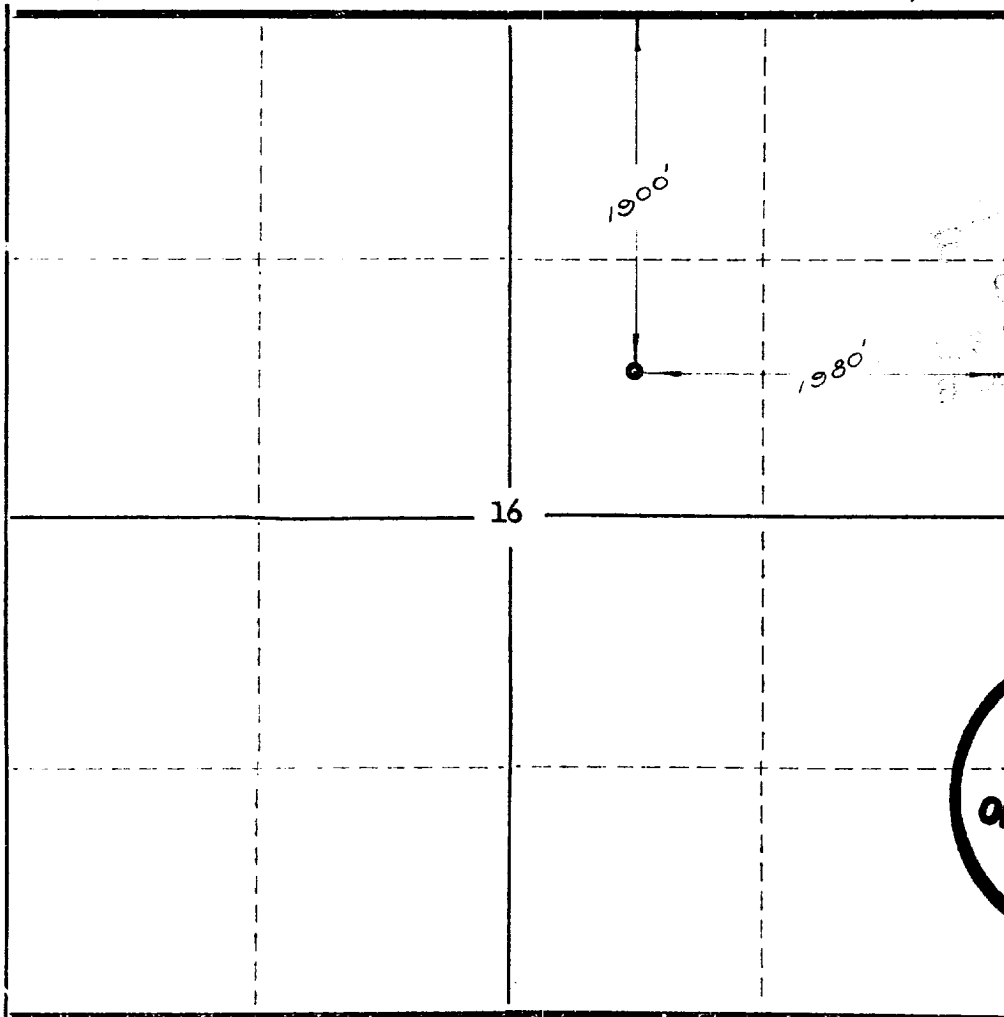
