On 7-8-8- ~~to~~ located hole in 5 1/2" casing between 2305 and 2225'. Set packer at 2154' and squeezed hole w/100 sacks of cement.

On 7-9-70 re-ran tubing, 2 3/8", 4.7# (5550') landed at 5561'. Baker Model "F" production packer set at 4780'. Loaded annulus above packer w/water treated w/55 gallons of Baroid B-1400 corrosion inhibitor.

Instructions
