Exception to R-333-C and D is hereby granted on Stanalind's Ute Indian Dakota Wells #1, 2, 3, and 5.

Due to existing conditions which do not allow the Annual Deliverability Tests to be taken as prescribed in Order R-333-C and D, a test shall be made as follows:

The Wells shall be shut in for a period of seven (7) days and the shut-in pressure measured. Such shut-in period shall be preceded by normal production for a minimum of twenty-one (21) days. This shut-in pressure shall be reported to the Commission in lieu of the annual deliverability test.
