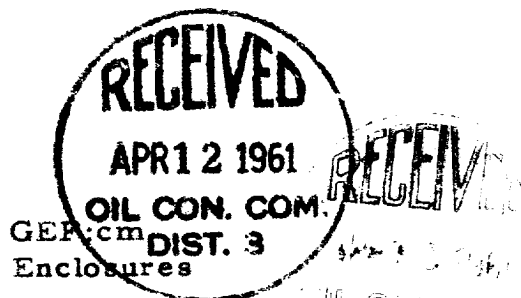

We are enclosing a Notice of Intention to Drill for our Robinson Bros. No. 1 Well, located in Unit P, Section 34-32N-13W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This is an unorthodox location since it is located 1235' from the south line and 760' from the east line of the section. The terrain is such that it is impractical to get further from the east line of the lease. There is an irrigation ditch immediately to the west, on the other side of the irrigation ditch is a rough, eroded bank leading down to the La Flata River. We, therefore, desire that you grant exception to this well location.

Consolidated Oil & Gas, Inc., is the only leasehold interest owner within 790' of this location and naturally does not object to this application. Consolidated is the leasehold owner of the SW/4 of Section 35 immediately to the east and the leasehold owner of the NE/4 of Section 3 immediately to the south. The attached well dedication plat indicates that the S/2 of Section 34 will be dedicated to this well.
