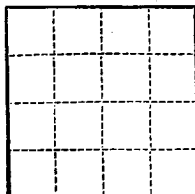

DETAILS OF WORK

Run up to drill through objective sand.

Set 4 1/2" 9.5# J-55 pipe casing through productive section with cement to protect producing zone.
