Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 330.04-acre non-standard gas proration unit within one mile from the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 32 North, Range 13 West, NMPM  
Section 35: W/2

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Tafoya Well No. 1, located 1180 feet from the South line and 1460 feet from the West line of said Section 35.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1 (b), Section 15 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-218-D, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 330.04 acres, subject to communitization of all working interests in the said 330.04-acre unit, if Colorado Western Exploration, Inc. is not the sole owner.
