Please find attached NMOCC Form C-102 for the subject well dated October 12, 1965 showing survey date of November 2, 1947. This well is an unorthodox location under the Ute Dome Paradox Pool Rules, but since it was drilled and completed prior to the adoption of rules for this pool, we presume that it will be considered standard. The acreage in adjacent Section 36, T-32-N, R-14-W, which this location crowds, is part of the same basic Ute Indians "A" lease and is also leased by Pan American.

In accordance with your request of Mr. Eaton, we have also extracted material from our well file from which you may construct a well file on this well. All of the forms filed during the original drilling of this well and its lengthy workover in 1951 were USGS forms which were filed with that agency and approved by them. It is believed that this set of forms plus the recently filed C-104 will bring your records up-to-date on this well.
