DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill Well No. 2 to around 1675' to test Gallup formation.

Our casing program is as follows:

- 30' - 7-5/8" OD 26.4# J-55 Casing - to be cemented with 10 sacks regular cement.
- 1675' - 4-1/2" OD 9.5# J-55 Casing - to be cemented with 75 sacks regular cement w/6% gal and 25% gilsonite and 25 sacks regular w/2% calcium chloride.
