Gentlemen:

This is to notify that the captioned well is now on Packer-Leakage Test. The Mesa Verde side is now on the initial flow period and the Dakota formation is shut in. On Friday, January 6, 1961, the Mesa Verde will be shut in and both Dakota and Mesa Verde will remain shut in until Friday, January 13. At this time the Dakota flow period will begin and the Mesa Verde will remain shut in, provided that F. P. C. clearance is granted for the sale of Dakota gas by this time.

This procedure is reported by Mr. Tenison to be somewhat in variance with the procedure originally agreed upon with Mr. Arnold. However, it is impossible to produce the Dakota until the above-mentioned F. P. C. clearance is obtained.
