Dear Sir:

It has come to our attention that Compass Exploration Company is drilling a well located on Navajo land known as the #1-32 Navajo well in the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> Section 32-32N-18W.

According to our information this well was spudded April 2, 1959 and is drilling at a depth of 3940 feet.

Your Notice of Intention to Drill was filed on this well with the United States Geological Survey Office in Farmington; however we have never received a copy of the Notice of Intention to Drill in our office and therefore have no record of the above operation. Will you please file two copies of the Federal Notice of Intention to Drill along with New Mexico Oil Commission Form C-128, Gas Well Location and Acreage Dedication Plat. Sufficient copies of all miscellaneous reports and well records should also be filed with the U.S.G.S. Office for forwarding to this office in duplicate.
