We are hereby requesting permission to run a deliverability retest on the above captioned well, located in Unit N, Section 26, T32N, R13W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

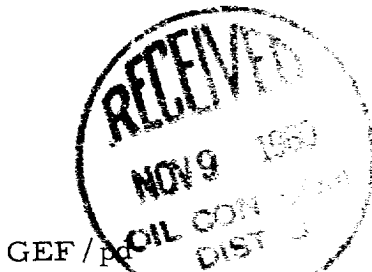
The reason for our request is that we feel the well was not sufficiently cleaned up when the initial deliverability test was run.
