HISTORY OF OIL OR GAS WELL

It is of the greatest importance to have a complete history of the well. Please state in detail the dates of redrilling, together with the reasons for the work and its results. If there were any changes made in the casing, state fully, and if any casing was "sidetracked" or left in the well, give its size and location. If the well has been dynamited, give date, size, position, and number of shots. If plugs or bridges were put in to test for water, state kind of material used, position, and results of pumping or bailing.

Air drilled 6-3/4" hole to 1805'. Cored with air 1702-21', recovered 11' shale, gray bentonite; 7' sandstone, gray, medium grained, glauconitic; 1' shale with streaks of limestone. Drilled to TP with air. Ran Gamma Ray-Induction and Density logs. Ran 1767' 5" casing and cemented with 25 sx. Perforated 1713-1720' with 4 jets per foot. Frac'd with 640 bbls crude and 15,000# sand. Breakdown pressure: 2800#; treating pressure 1500#. Injection rate 22 bbls per minute. Recovered all load oil on 1-22-63 and potentialled for 102 bbls oil in 24 hrs.
