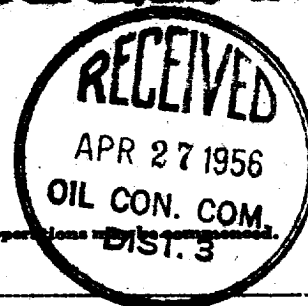

Ave. injection rate was 1 1/2 bbl/min. 31 gal. after 10 min. 6309'.
