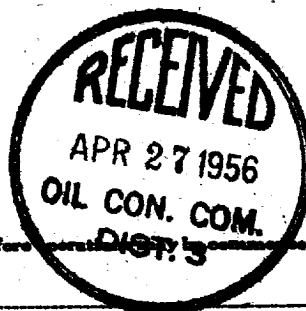

March 31, 1956: DST No. 11 from 6795' to 6850' w/ Johnston tool w/ 1" top and 3/4" bottom chisel. Tool open 1 hour. Fair blow throughout test. Initial and 3000#, Min. fl. 725#, max. fl. 2145#, final 3000#. 20 after 30 minutes DST. Recovered 130' of muddy water and 486' brackish water. Chloride: top 16,000 PPM, bottom water 48,000 PPM. Test satisfactory.
