3/15/56: 1ST 90' from 6090' to 6180' w/Johansen tool w/1" top and 3/4" bottom chisel. Tool open 1-1/2 hrs. Fair blow throughout test. Initial mud 2150', min. and max. flowing 0', final 2150'. Build up after 30 min. 700'. Recovered 150' gas odor in drill pipe and 95' gas out mud. Chloride in ditch 300 ppm, in test 300 ppm. Test satisfactory.
