Plug & Abandonment Report

Cementing Summary:

Plug #1 with 43 sxs Class B cement from 1267' to 710' to fill Gallup perforations and cover top.

Plug #2 with 50 sxs Class B cement pumped down 4-1/2" casing from 84' to surface, circulate good cement to surface.

Plugging Summary:

Notified BLM on 3/14/97

3-14-97 Road rig to location. RU rig and equipment. Open up well, no pressure. Install wellhead. NU BOP and test, OK. PU and RIH with 42 joints 2-3/8" tubing, tag bottom at 1281'. PU tubing to 1267'. Establish circulation with 3 bbls water. Plug #1 with 43 sxs Class B cement from 1267' to 710' to fill Gallup perforations and cover top. POH and LD tubing. Shut in well and WOC overnight. SDFD.

3-17-97 Safety Meeting. Open up well, no pressure. Pressure test casing to 300# for 10 min, held OK. RU A-Plus wireline truck and RIH; tag cement at 759'. Perforate 2 squeeze holes at 84'. Establish circulation out bradenhead with 10 bbls water. Plug #2 with 50 sxs Class B cement pumped down 4-1/2" casing from 84' to surface, circulate good cement to surface. Shut in well and WOC. Dig out wellhead. ND BOP. Cut wellhead off; found cement down 5' in 4-1/2" casing and 7-5/8" annulus. Mix 15 sxs Class B cement, fill casing and annulus; then install P&A marker. RD rig and equipment; move off location. J. Sanchez, BLM representative was on location.
