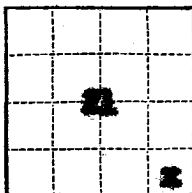

25 sacks cement plug from 8230' to 8286'
40 sacks cement plug from 8280' to 8120'
40 sacks cement plug from 7450' to 7450'
40 sacks cement plug from 6300' to 6400'
40 sacks cement plug from 5410' to 5510'
10 sacks cement plug from 4140' to 4160'

in bottom of intermediate string. Cut and pulled 1200' of 9 5/8" CD 36# intermediate casing.

75 sacks cement plug from 1300' to 1100'
25 sacks cement plug from 100' to 210'
20 sacks cement plug from 0' to 25'

A dry hole marker has been set, pits fenced and location cleaned.
