Objective Horizon: Gallup (Hernandez) sandstone at approximately 1765'.


Anticipated TD: 1815' in Sarcobatus formation.

Plan to run 1800' of 4 1/2" oil string inside 6 1/4" hole with cement to rise 300' above highest perforation and sand-oil frac in the approximate amount of 10,000 gallons and 20,000#.


