This letter is to bring your files up to date regarding the drilling operations of our Ute #6, SW¼ SW¼, Sec. 17, T. 32N, R. 14W, Barker Creek Dome, San Juan County, New Mexico. Hereafter a weekly letter, reporting these operations, will be written each Friday to be in your office the first of the following week.

The spud date was October 26, 1950.
343' of 13-3/8 re lb. casing was set and cemented to top.
Top of the Dakota formation was encountered at 2413'.
Top of the Morrison formation was encountered at 2651'.
2668' of 9-5/8 36 lb. casing was set and cemented to top.
The casing was tested under 900 psi and found tight.
The well is now drilling at 4000' in red rock.
