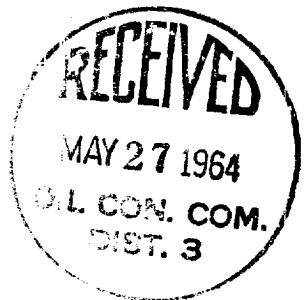
By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104 of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception for the above-described unorthodox well location.

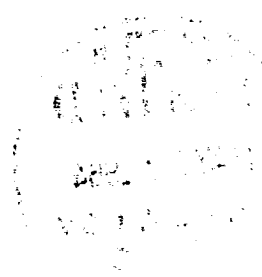
