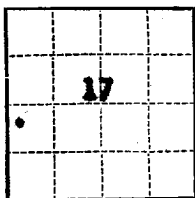

Notched w/jet-notch gun @ 1444' & 1446'. Fractured with 20,000# of 10-20 sand, 20,000# of 20-40 sand and 1000 barrels of oil. SEP 22300#, minimum injection pressure 2500#, maximum injection pressure 3500#, average injection rate 37.8 BPM. Sand concentration varied from 1/2 gal to 1 1/2 gal. BSIP - 1300#, 30 minute SIP - 1120#.
