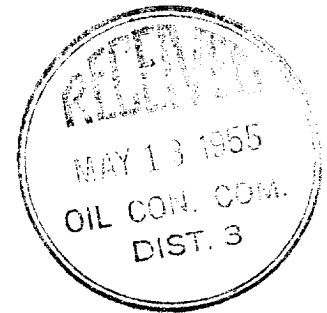

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 336.40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM

All of Section 11

Flying within 700 feet of line

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Hubbard Well No. 2, located 990 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line of Section 11, in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 11, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico,

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1, Section (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-128-C, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned there-to in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 336.40 acres.
