

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 29, 1966, for permission to dually complete its Culpepper-Martin Well No. 12 located in Unit N of Section 20, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 19th day of September, 1966, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Culpepper-Martin Well No. 12 located in Unit N of Section 20, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 11-A, Article 11-A of the Commission's Regulations, the New Mexico Oil Commission has received an application for a dual comparison of the Martin Well No. 1, located in Unit 11 of Section 10, Township 12 North, Range 13 West, Santa Fe County, New Mexico, to produce gas from the Martin-Weaver Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 15th day of September, 1955, the Commission's Secretary finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 11-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided to the operators of offset surveys have been duly notified and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the period as prescribed by said rule;
- (4) That the proposed dual comparison will not cause waste or impair correlative rights;
- (5) That the resolution of the proposed dual comparison is feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Santa Fe Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to duly complete its dual comparison of the Martin Well No. 1, located in Unit 11 of Section 10, Township 12 North, Range 13 West, Santa Fe County, New Mexico, to produce gas from the Martin-Weaver Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the existing casing and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 11-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall also seal and abandon wells upon completion and annually thereafter during the annual deliverability tests period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this case is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
