In view of this letter, we are requesting approval from the Santa Fe City Council.

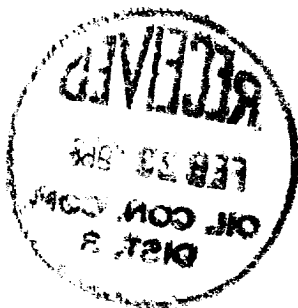

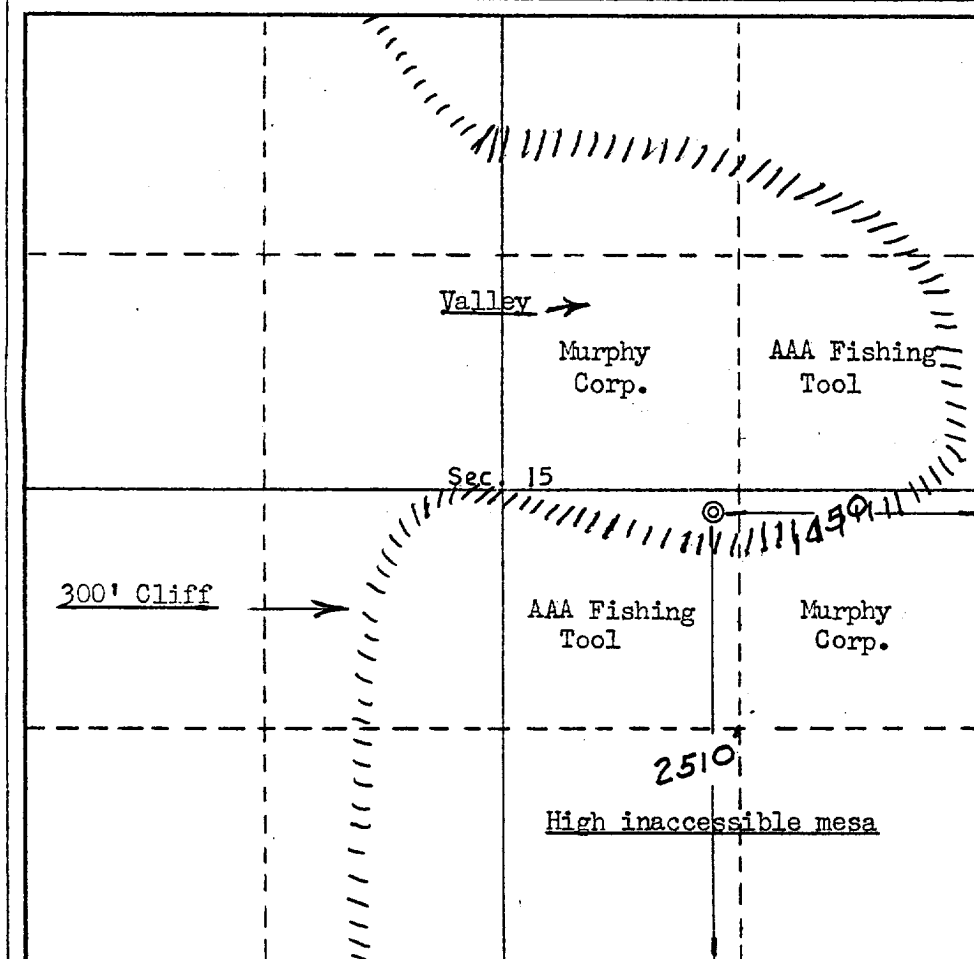
