Dear Virgil:

On August 23, 1995, Ernest Cardona tried to run a mechanical integrity test on the above-mentioned well. The well couldn't be tested as there was no packer or tubing in the well bore. After a review of the gas injection well, our records show that the well has been shut-in.

According to Rule #705C paragraph one of the New Mexico Rules & Regulations Manual, whenever there is a continuous six-month period of non injection into any injection project, storage project, salt water disposal well or special purpose injection well, such project or well will be considered abandoned and the authority for injection will automatically terminate <u>ipso facto.</u>

Authorization to inject into the La Plata Mancos Unit #4 gas injection well has been canceled as of October 6, 1995.
