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## NORTHWEST NEW MEDICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

1. A packer leakage nest shall be commenced on each multiply complexed well within seven days after acreal completion of the well, and annually thereafter as prescribed by the order arthorizing the multiple complexion. Such tests shall also be commenced on all multiple completions within seven days following recompletion and/or chemical or fracrare resument, and whenever remedial work has been done on a well during which the packet or the rubing have been disturbed. Term shall also be taken at any time that communicition is superred or ones requested by the Division.

- 2. At least 22 hours prior to the commencement of any packer leakage test, the operator shall notify the Division in writing of the exact time the sext is to be commenced. Offset operators shall also be so morified.
- 3. The packer leakage test shall commence when both roots of the dual completion are shut-in for previore subdirection. Both cones shall remain shut-in until the well-head pressure in each has stabilized, provided however, that they need not restain abut-in store
- 4. For Flow Test No. 1, one zone of the dual completion shall be produced at the normal race of production while the other some remains short-in. Such test shall be continued for seven days in the case of a gas well and for 24 hours in the case of an oil well. Mose: if, on an initial packer leakage test, a gas well is being flowed to the atmosphere due to the lack of a pipeline connection the flow period shall be three bours.
- ). Following completion of Flow Test No. 1, the well shall again be shot-in, in accordence with Paragraph 3 above.
- 6. How Text'No. I shall be conducted even though no leak was indicated during flow Test No. 1. Procedure for Flow Test No. 2 is so be the same as for Flow Test No. 1 except

- that the previously produced 2000 shall remain about in while the 2000 which was previously short in is produced.
- 7. Pressures for gas-zone tests must be measured on each zone with a deadweight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3 hours sexus immediately prior to the beginning of each flow-period, at fateen-minute intervals during the first hour thereof, and at hously intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period, 7-day series immediately prior to the beginning of each flow period, at least one time during each flow period (at approximately the midway point) and inverdintely prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have previously shown questionable sest dies.

14-hour oil some text: all pressures, throughout the entire text, shall be continuously measured and recorded with recording pressure gauges the accuracy of which sount be checked at least rover, and at the beginning and once at the end of each test, with a desdroighe pressure gauge. If a well is a gra-oil or an oil-gas dual complexion, the recording grade shall be required on the oil some only, with deseweight pressures so required shove being taken on the gas some.

8. The results of the above-described nests shall be filed in triplicate within 19 days after correpletion of the test. Tests shall be filed with the Astre Dutter Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on Northwest New Mexico Packet Leakage Test Form Revises 10-01-78 with all deadweight pressures indicated thereon as well as the flowing temperatura (gre seem only) and gravity and GOR (oil seem only).
