



APPROVAL - CERTIFICATION - DETERMINATION



Pursuant to the authority vested in the Secretary of the Interior under Section 17(j) of the Mineral Leasing Act of 1920, as amended (74 Stat. 784; 30 U.S.C. 226(j)), and delegated to the Area Oil and Gas Supervisors of the U.S. Geological Survey, I do hereby:

- A. Approve the attached communitization agreement covering the S/2 of Section 29, Township 32 North, Range 11 West, N.M.P.M.,

San Juan County, New Mexico,

as to - natural gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons

- producible from the

- B.
