

THE APPLICATION OF CONSOLIDATED OIL
AND GAS, INC. FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-2801

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Consolidated Oil and Gas, Inc. made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on December 29, 1980, for permission to dually complete its Robinson Bros No. 1 in Unit M of Section 34, Township 32 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool and the Basin Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 20th day of April, 1981, the Division Director finds:

1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;

2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;

3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Consolidated Oil and Gas, Inc., be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Robinson Bros No. 1 located in Unit M of Section 34, Township 32 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Blanco Mesaverde Pool and the Basin Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
