
Dear Charlie:

As we discussed Hallwood Petroleum has plugged the Robinson #34-1 Well just recently. Jewel McGee, the landowner where this well is located, has asked that Hallwood cut off the pipe on this well so that it is below plow depth. He would like to be able to use this land for a cultivated field and is already getting the adjoining land ready for planting this spring. Hallwood is agreeable to doing this if the NMOCD allows it.

Attached please find a copy of the letter that the landowner has sent requesting that this be done. If the NMOCD is agreeable to letting Hallwood do this, I would appreciate it if you could fax me a letter at the above number stating so. Hallwood will then make the necessary arrangements to cut the pipe off. They will also remove the anchors and do some other clean up work at the same time as they cut off the pipe.
