Emerald Gas Operating Company is commencing testing operations on the above well. For the purpose of cleaning up the well bore and estimating the correct size of surface production equipment, Emerald requests approval to vent or flare gas for a period of no more than five total days over a 90 day window. Vented gas will not exceed 5,000 MCF and is expected to be significantly less than that, in the 30 to 150 MCF per day range. This testing is a standard and integral part of the initial testing and hooking up process and is necessary to evaluate equipment needs and get the gas into the sales line.
