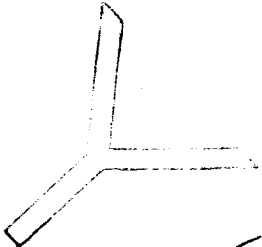
Enclosed please find Blanket Bond Form
