DETAILS OF WORK

Well drilled under name of William Mansfield to 1927 feet from May 18 to 23, 1943.
Cemented 8-5/8 inch casing at 1890 feet with 30 sacks by Halliburton.
Perforated Farmington sand from 1800 to 1890. Recovered salt water from 1800-80 feet.
Propose to squeeze off from 1800-80 and test gas production and drill to 2050 to test lower Farmington sand which showed up on electrical log in our well number 4 to the east.
If the lower Farmington sand is dry wish to continue with rotary tools to bottom of Mesaverde at approximately 5200 feet. Will inform you of final results.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
