We received your drillers log on the Spanish Bit #1 well, McKinley County, New Mexico and I have enclosed the required number of copies of Forms C-102, C-103 and C-105.

It will be necessary for you to submit your proposed plugging program on Form C-102. This should be OK'd by this office or by Al Greer in Aztec before the well is actually plugged. It is possible we might want somebody at the well to witness the plugging. Also, you should understand that in transferring this well for use as a water well it will be necessary for the new owner to assume full responsibility for the well in writing to this office before the present operator can be released from his bond obligation. In any well that encounters numerous water zones, we are generally rather critical of the plugging program, so I would suggest you submit your plugging program at your earliest convenience.
