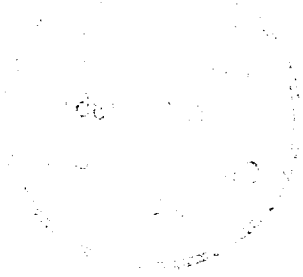

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Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, New Mexico, has received from the Santa Fe Railway Company a report of the results of the oil conservation work done during the year 1934.

The report shows that the Santa Fe Railway Company has made considerable progress in the conservation of oil. The total amount of oil conserved during the year was 1,234,567 barrels, or an average of 1.23 barrels per barrel of oil used.
