DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

1/16/52 - Plugging up spudder. Jan 19 snubbed casing dry to 3690. Let hole stand four hours for casing test. No fluid entered hole. Casing tested okay. Jan 20 cleaned out with cable tools to 3692. Let hole stand four hours for water shut off test. No fluid entered hole after four hours. Water shut off okay. Jan 21, 1952 cleaned out to bottom 3684. Jan 22-24 loaded hole with 173 qts of oil well explosives by dumping and 152 qts in shells (325 qts total). Top of shot 3696. Placed 4' gravel bridge on top of shot. Dumped 16 ac cement on top of gravel. Loaded hole with water to surface. Jan 25, 1952 shot exploded okay. Jan 26 - 29 cleaned out hole to 3790. No visible gas but slight odor. Ran 119 jts 2 1/2" tubing - hung at 3685. Plugged up lines tree Feb 2, 1952 after 48 hours shut in. All had not built up any pressure.
