DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

July 6, 1952 - moved in aquifer, pulled tubing, cleaned out hole to bottom.  
July 14, loaded hole with 277 qts oil well explosives from 3762-3760. Taped shot with 4' gravel pack. 12 oz. delayed on top gravel. Loaded hole with water.  
July 16 shot exploded okay. Swabbed hole dry. Drilled out chisel plug.  
July 17 cleaned out to 3705 - no gas.  
July 18-22 cleaned out to 3760 - no gas. Shut well in 24 hours for pressure test.  
July 24, 1952, well shut in 48 hours - no pressure, no gas. Preparing to abandon well.
