DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

It is proposed to run, set and cement a string of 11-3/4 inch surface pipe to the top of the Mancos Shale estimated to be at a depth of 50 feet, and drill a cable-tool hole to the top of the Dakota formation estimated to be at approximately 2600 feet; to run, set and cement 7 inch O. D. oil well casing at this point and drill and test the Dakota formation. If any porous formation carrying oil, gas or water is encountered in the drilling of the Mancos Shale, the same will be tested and if not capable of producing in commercial quantities the same will be shut off behind the seven inch pipe either with heavy mud or cement. Cement will be circulated to assure a shut-off of such formations if necessary. Cement will be circulated to the surface behind the surface casing and the production casing will be cemented with not less than 100 sacks of cement. Survey of location is attached.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
