Notice of Intention to Abandon Well, Form G-101a, was approved January 28, 1952. Well was permanently plugged and abandoned as follows: 1. Plugged hole with solid cement from bottom of hole to 1031 feet; 2. 7" casing was shot free at 1865 feet and 1862 feet of 7" casing was recovered; 3. A 15 sack cement plug was set at 1865 feet, a 10 sack cement plug was set at 236 feet and a 20 sack cement plug was set at surface of hole; 4. Hole was filled with 12 pound mud between intervals of cement plugs, 5. Erected 4' pipe marker and restored ground level to original contours as per regulations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
