1. Existing Roads:

As shown on attached plat entitled "Existing and Proposed Roads and Pipeline Right-of-Way".

2. Planned Access Roads:

From existing road through SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south to location. As shown on attached plat entitled "Existing and Proposed Roads and Pipeline Right-of-Way".

3. Location of Wells:

As shown on attached plat entitled "Existing and Proposed Roads and Pipeline Right-of-Way".

4. Lateral Roads to Well Locations:

As shown on attached plat entitled "Existing and Proposed Roads and Pipeline Right-of-Way".

5. Location of Tank Batteries and Flow Lines:

As shown on attached plat entitled "Location and Equipment Layout".

6. Location and Type of Water Supply:

An excavated water hole located in Yeguas Wash (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 13, T 25N, R 1W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico).

7. Method of Handling Waste Disposal:

Waste will be buried in burn pit or reserve pit as applicable.

9. Location of Airstrips: (Existing Airstrip)

Adjacent to camp site described above.

10. Location Layout to Include Position of Rig, Mud Tanks,
Reserve Pit, Burn Pit, Pipe Racks, Etc.:

Layout, Puerto Chiquito #24 (A-9)".

11. Plans for Restoration of the Surface:

All excavations will be filled and surface leveled.
Surface will then be reseeded.

12. Other Information:

This location within boundaries of Santa Fe National Forest
and Benson-Montin-Greer has filed application for Special Use
Permit with the U. S. Forest Service in compliance with
stipulations attached to oil and gas lease covering lands in
National Forest. Forest Ranger from the Cuba District has
inspected the proposed road and location.

Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corp. as operator of communized quarter section proposes to drill a Mancos Formation well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 26 North, Range 1 East. 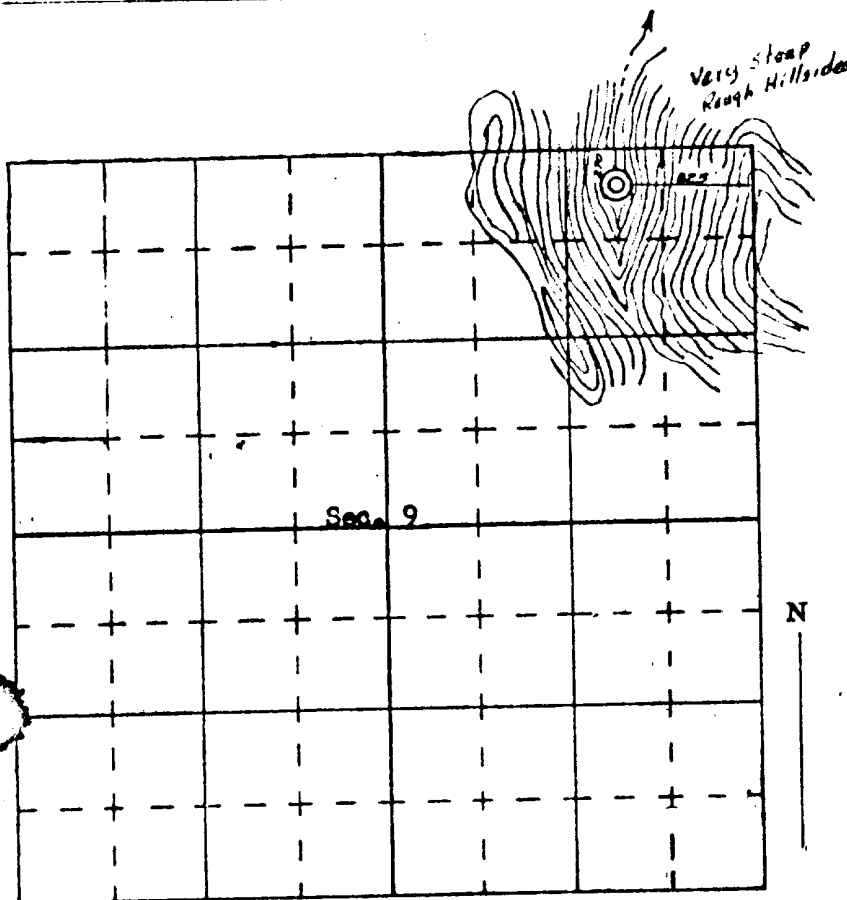

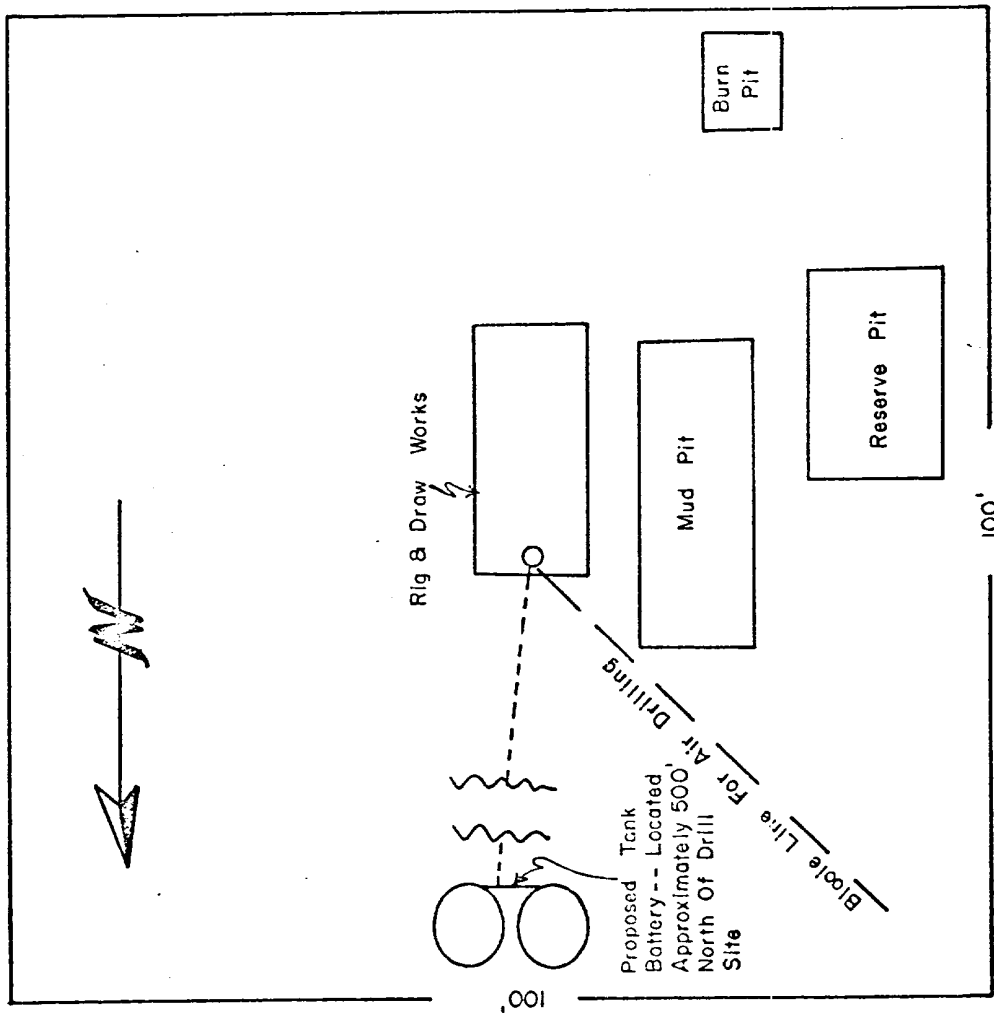

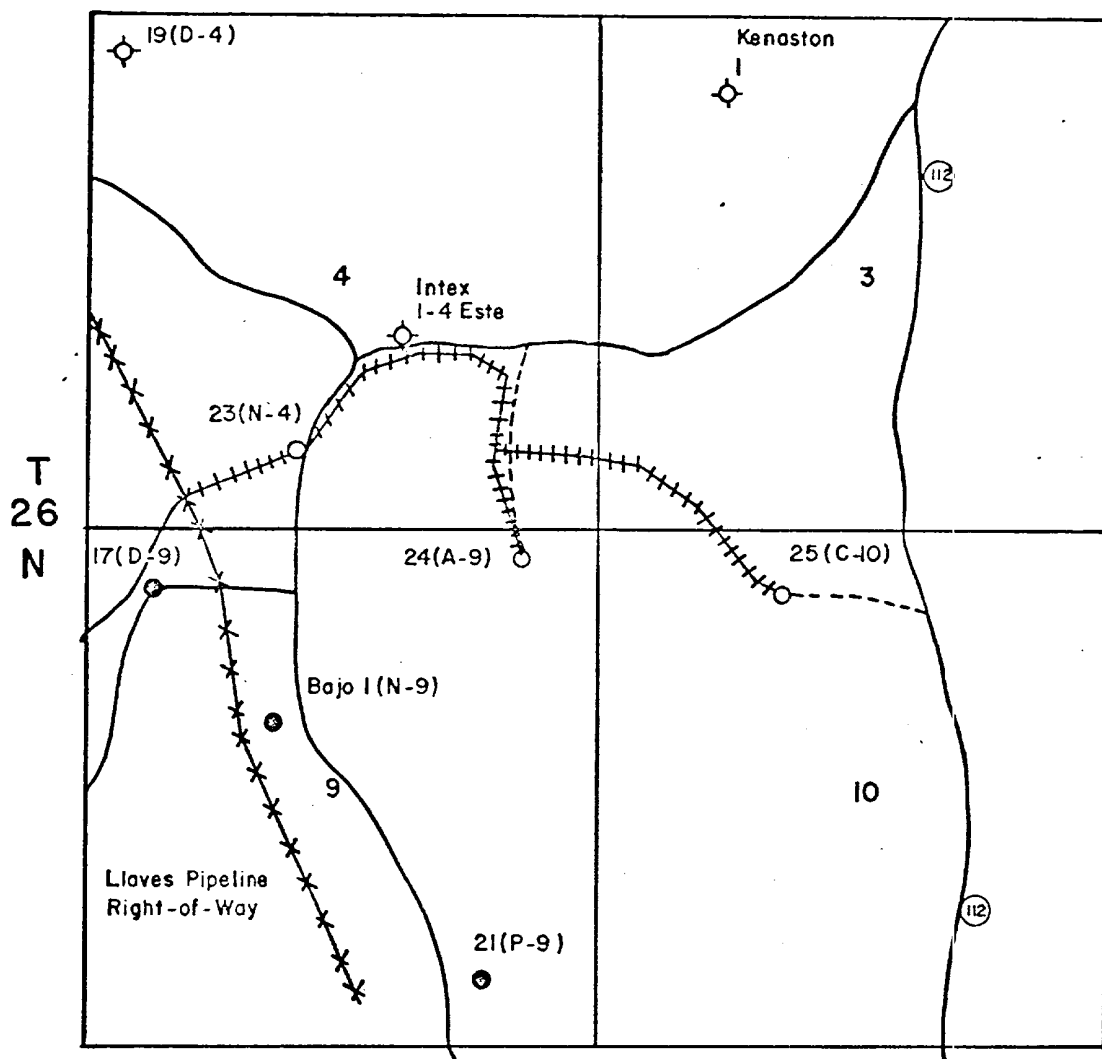
LOCATION AND EQUIPMENT LAYOUT PUERTO CHIQUITO #24 (A-9)
