Dear Mr. Phillips:

We have just received a copy of the Notice of Intention to Drill which you have filed with the United States Geological Survey in Farmington on your #18-22 "E" well in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22-26N-3W.

This Notice of Intention to Drill has attached 2 copies of Form C-128, one for the Pictured Cliffs portion dedicating 320 acres and one for the Mesaverde dedicating 160 acres. We notice that you have designated the well as a wildcat in the Mesaverde Formation and we presume this is why you have dedicated only 160 acres. This area has now been taken into the Blanco Mesaverde gas pool by Order R-983; therefore please re-file Form C-128 in triplicate with this office showing a 320-acre acreage dedication for the Mesaverde portion.
