



DETAILS OF WORK

5 1/2" pipe was cemented at 949 feet. We propose to drill out cement plug and clean out to 1370 feet, which includes drilling out the Halliburton plug and 20 feet of cement set at 1030 feet. The formations between 1370 feet and 1030 feet will be cemented. The formations between 1030 feet and 1010 feet, and between 1050 feet and 1060 feet will be shot with approximately 167 quarts of nitro glycerin.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
