DETAILS OF WORK

A 7-1/2 inch hole was drilled with rotary tools to a depth of 1670 feet where 1670 feet of 5-1/2 inch casing was cemented with 100 sacks of cement. Cable tools were moved on and the cement plug drilled and the hole bailed dry. The hole was tested for two hours for water, and it was found that a satisfactory oil and gas job was had, and the well was drilled with cable tools to a total depth of 1767 feet.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
