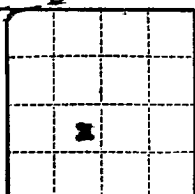

## DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to set 8 5/8" casing at 100' with sufficient cement to circulate, WOC 24 hours, and test casing to 1000# for 30 minutes. We propose to drill a 6 3/4" hole to approximately 1700 feet. This is a "strat" test and will be plugged as directed by U.S.G.S. Attached are copies of well location plat and a tract survey of Sections 22, 23, 26, and 27, T28N, R17W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

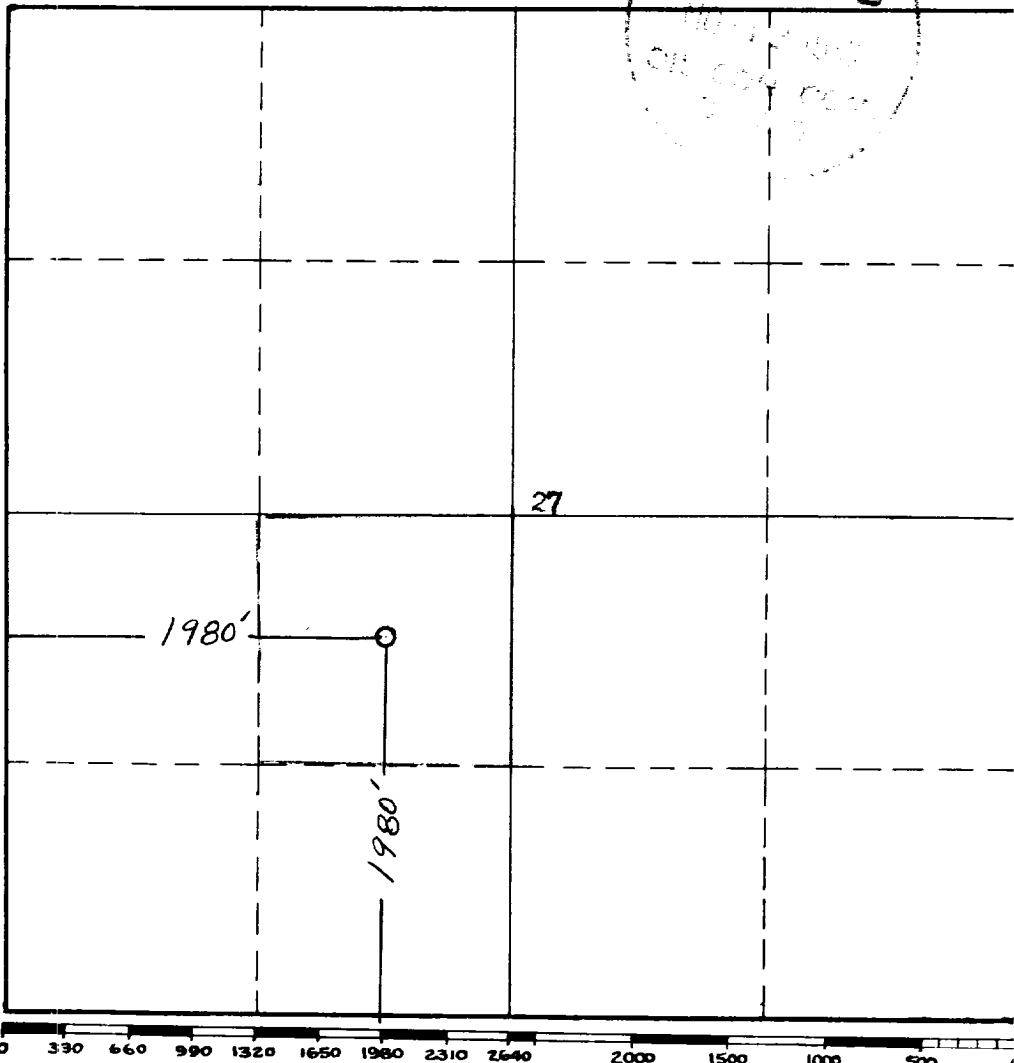
