Dear Dr. Kendall:

A recent inspection of your Hare Lease indicates that the referenced SWD well is in violation of SWD Order R-8419. The order states that injection be performed through plastic lined tubing installed in a packer set within 100' of the top perforation. The wellhead configuration reveals that you have been injecting down the 4 1/2" casing as the well is not equipped with tubing. The order further states that "at no time shall the surface pressure exceed zero PSI." Although the well was down when I was present, the Murphy Switch was set at 350 PSI and there was pressure on the casing. A review of our records also shows that injected volumes are not being reported on Form C 120A as required by Rule 1120.

You are hereby directed to cease injection until you are in compliance with the Order R-8419, Rule 1120 and until further notice from this office. There may be another problem with the well in that a small amount of water is percolating into the cellar from outside the original 6 5/8" casing. As I am sure you are aware, the water table in this area is very shallow and this seep may be occurring naturally. It may also be caused by the over-pressurized injection. If the latter proves to be the case, remedial action will be necessary.
