

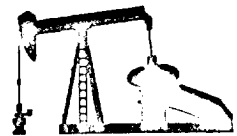

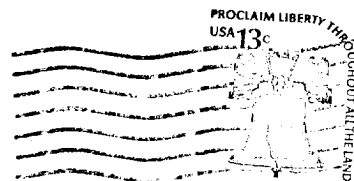
We would like to make

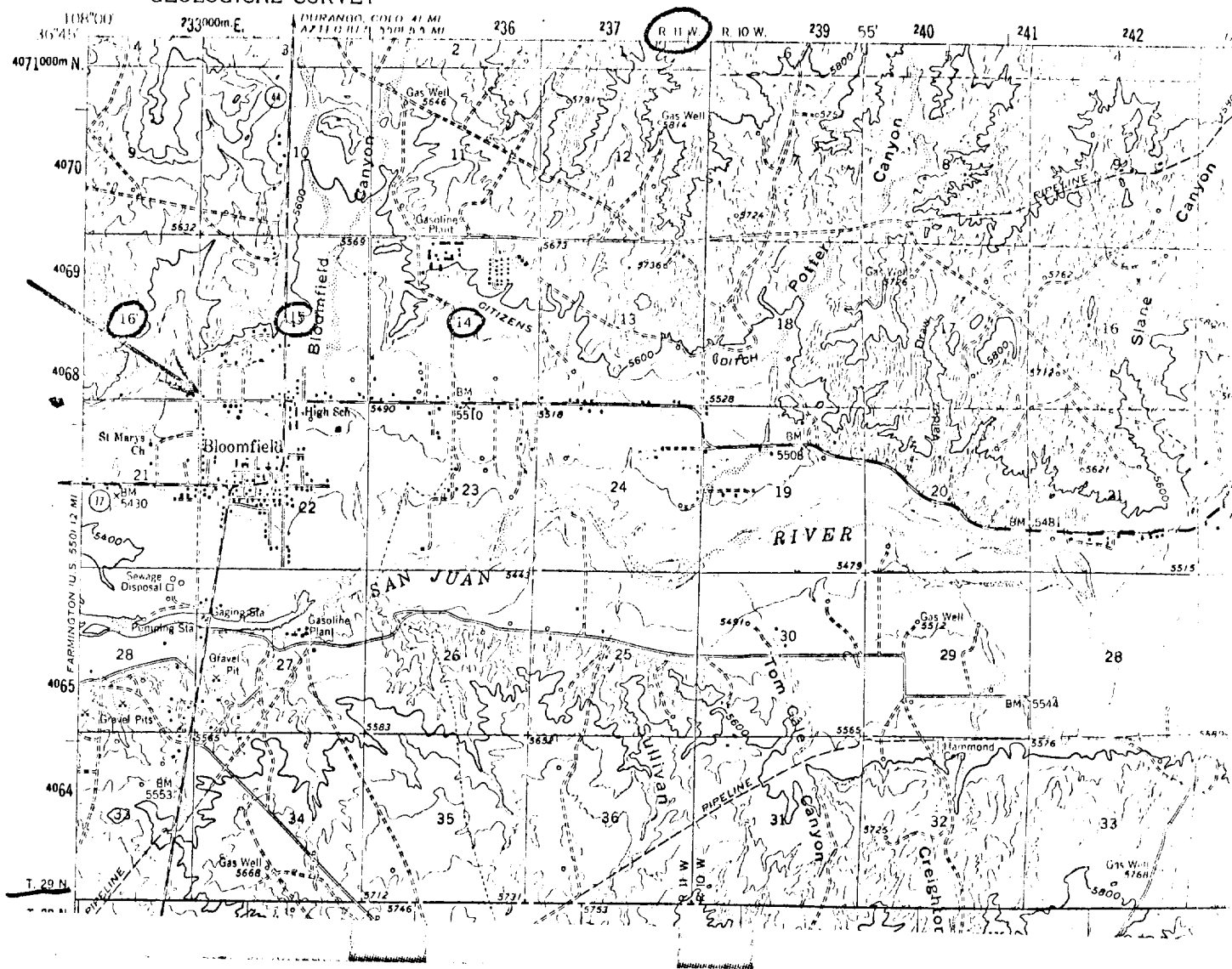
